## Jewellery Sizing Guide

## How to measure your ring size.

The chart below displays ring size information and is a useful starting point in finding out what ring size is right for you.
Keep in mind that your finger changes in size during the day so it's best to measure it at the end of the day when the finger is at its largest. Heat and cold also affects the size of the finger

Take a piece of string or a strip of paper and wrap it around the base of your finger. Mark the material with a pen at the point at which it completes the circle. Measure the length from the start of the material to the point where you have marked (measure it in millimetres). This gives you your finger circumference, from which you can refer to the size chart below.

## How to measure your Costume or Fashion Jewellery Bangle Size

Bangles should be worn in the smallest size possible for the best look and the least amount of damage while you are wearing your bangles. To judge the best bangle size you need to factor your wrist size and your hand size. For this reason bangles are measured by their interior diameter. In order to wear a bangle you must be able to slide it over your hand.

One of the best ways to judge your bangle size is to use bangles that you already have and measure the inside diameter so that you can compare to the below measurement chart or the measurement stated in the actual bangle listing.

As long as you measure the inside diameter of your current bangles this will be an accurate way to find your bangle size.
